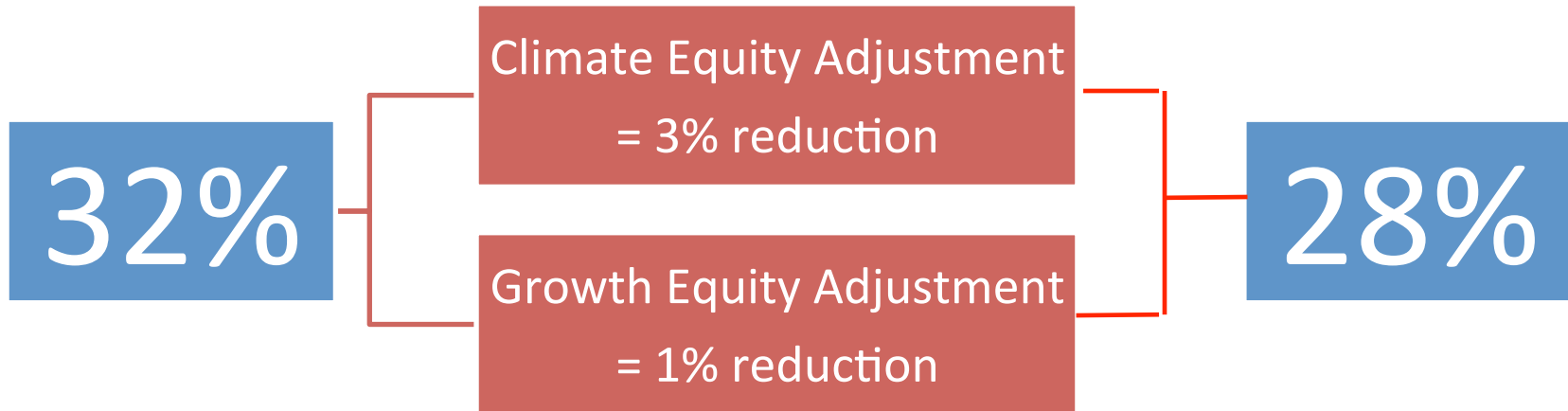

Good News – Submitted Adjustments



State Water Resources Control Board approved
Western's climate and growth adjustment



- Emergency Regulations (June '15 – February '16) Conservation Standard = 32%
- Extended Regulations (March '16 – October '16) Conservation Standard = 28%

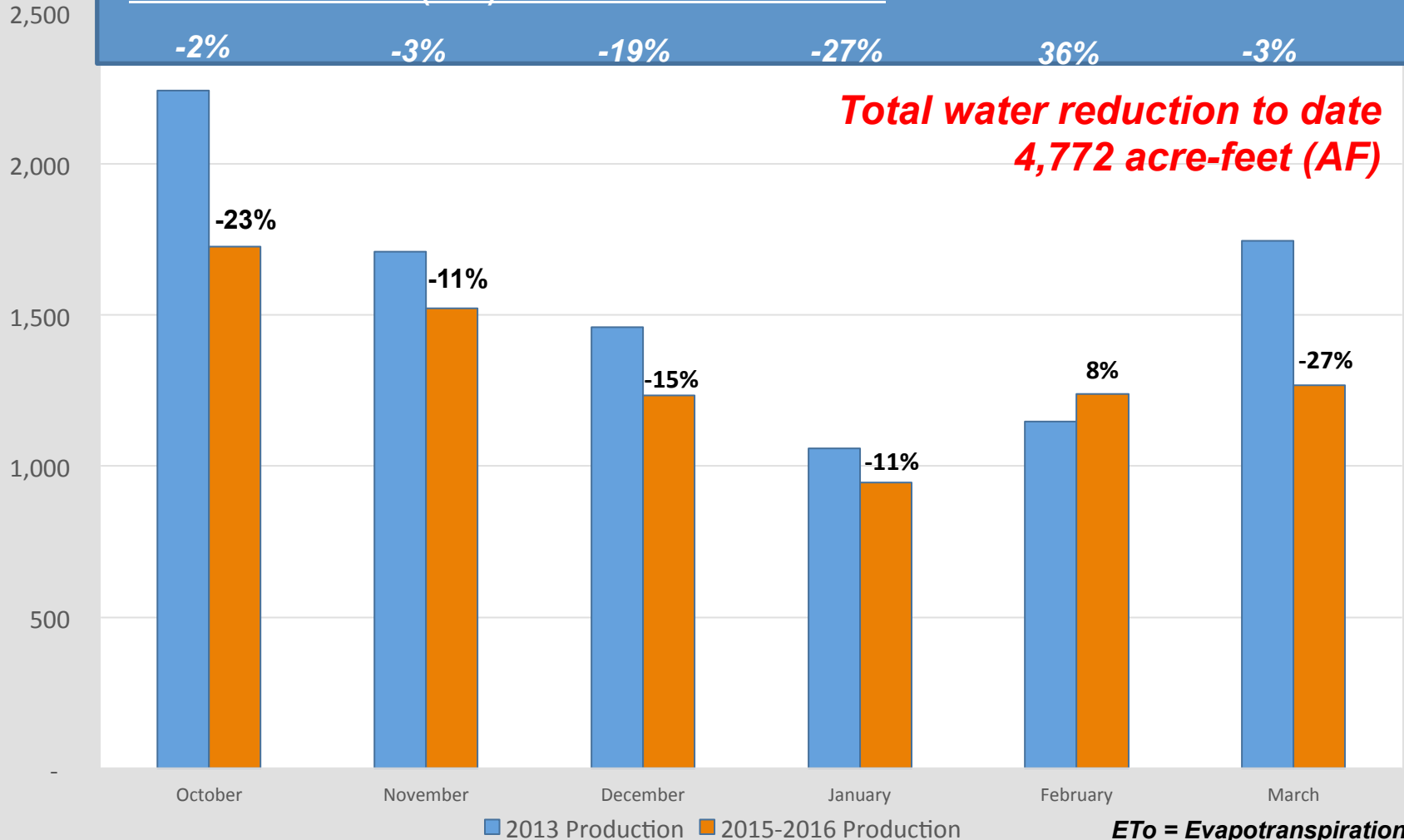

Weather Difference (ETo) 2015/2016 relative to 2013



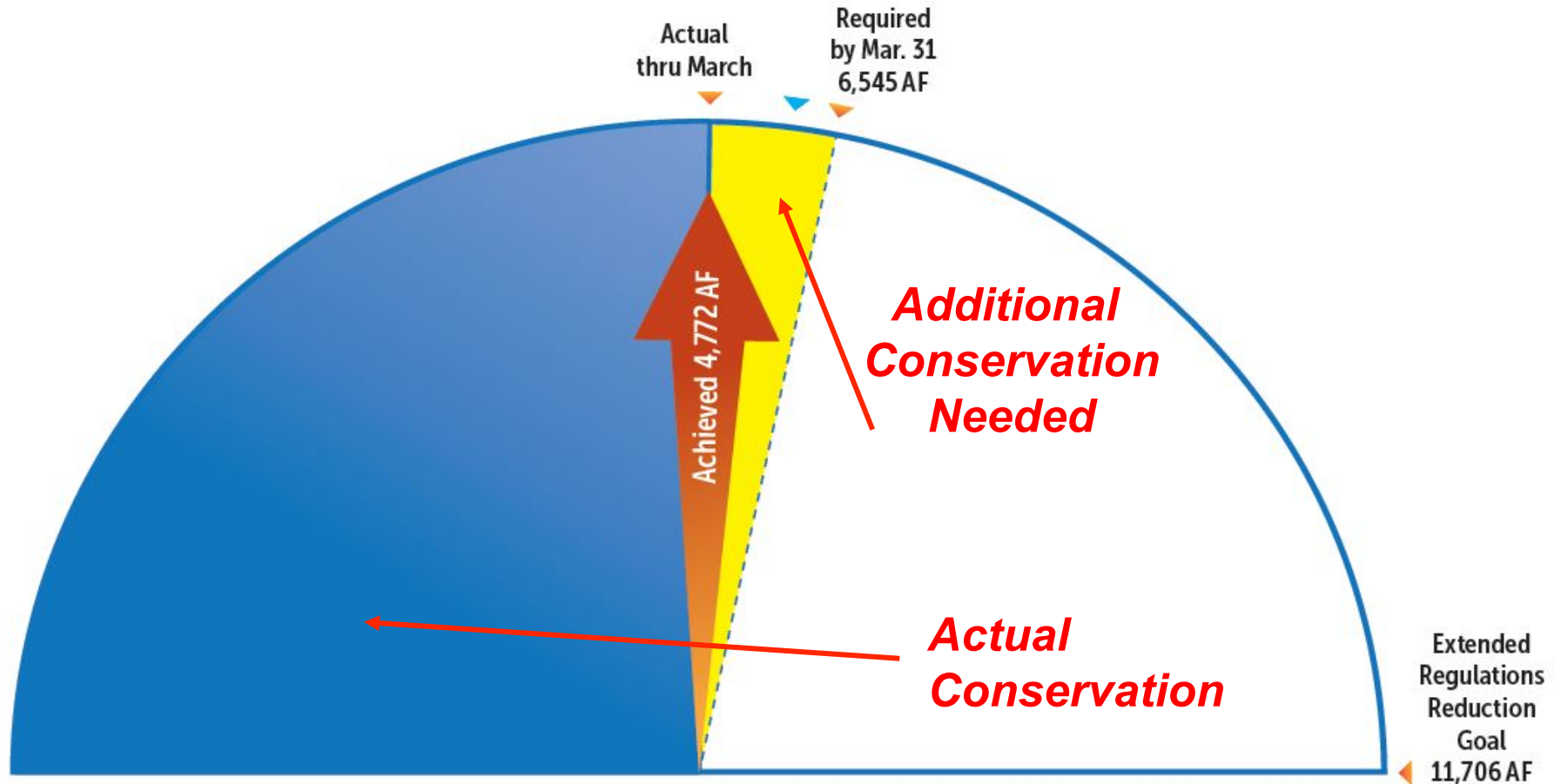
**Total water reduction to date

- Emergency Regulations (June '15 – February '16) cumulative reduction was 23% (4,293 AF)
- Extended Regulations (March '16 – October '16) cumulative reduction is 27% (479 AF)

City of Corona	28%	28%	Denied climate adjustment.*
Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District	28%	27%	Denied climate adjustment.* Approved growth adjustment.
Jurupa Community Services District	28%	23%	Approved climate and growth adjustment.
City of Norco	36%	36%	Denied climate adjustment.*
Rancho California Water District	36%	32%	Approved climate and growth adjustment.
City of Riverside	28%	25%	Approved climate adjustment. Denied supply adjustment—not a qualifying drought-resilient supply.
Riverside Highland Water Company	36%	33%	Did not apply for climate adjustment. Approved growth adjustment.
Rubidoux Community Services District	28%	20%	Denied climate adjustment.* Approved supply adjustment.
Temescal Valley Water District	32%	31%	Denied climate adjustment.* Approved growth adjustment.
