

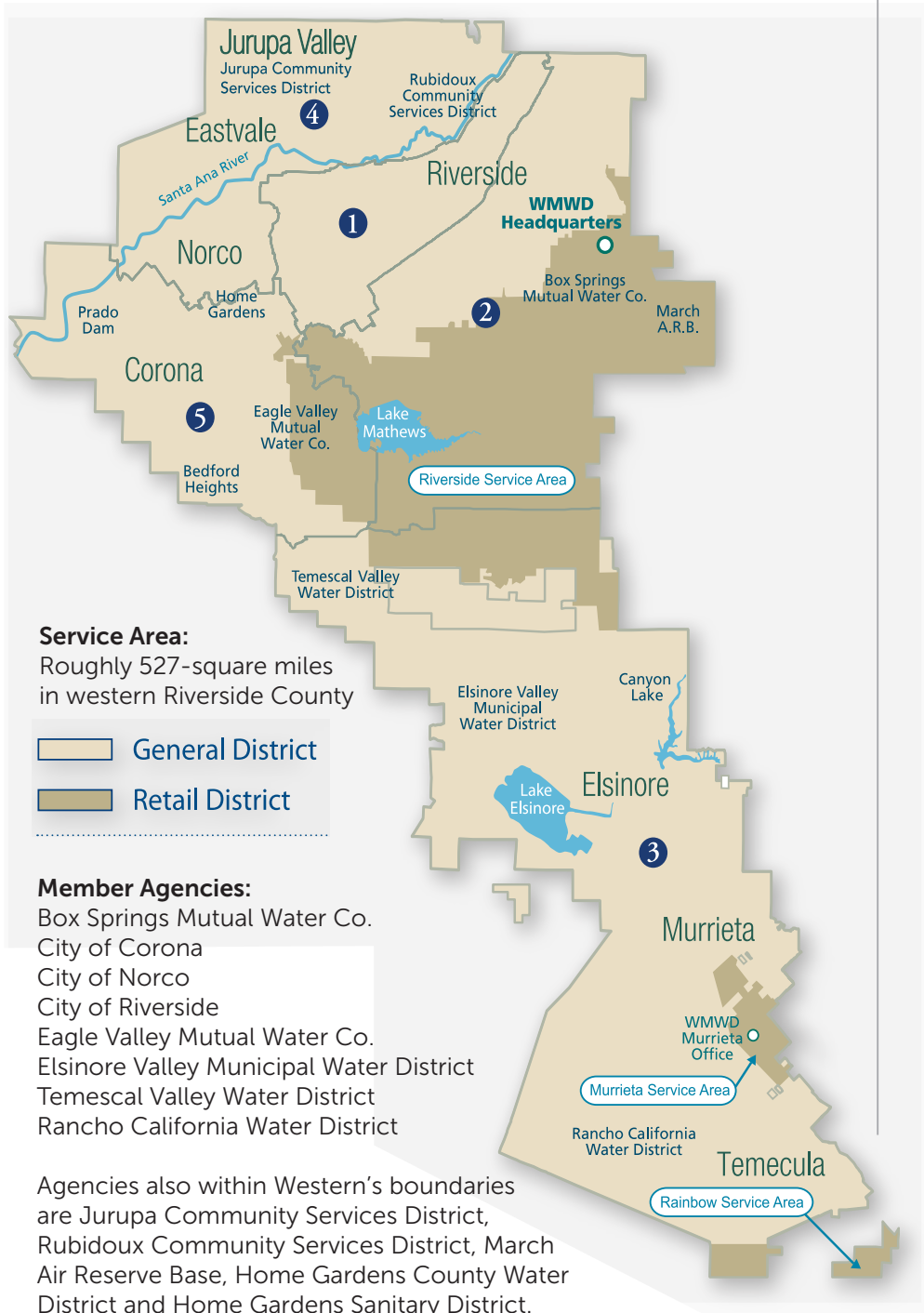

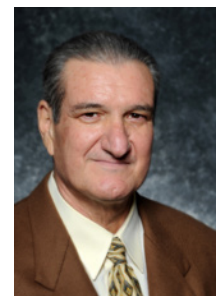

Western's resources support **25,000** wholesale, business and residential customers.



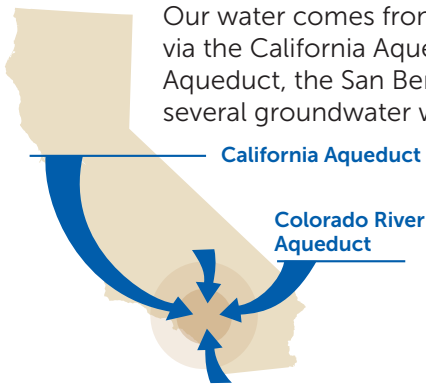

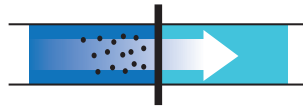


## Our Water

Our water comes from the Northern California via the California Aqueduct, the Colorado River Aqueduct, the San Bernardino basin and several groundwater wells in Murrieta.



We recycle 3 million gallons of water per day - that is enough to fill **20,000,000 bathtubs!**

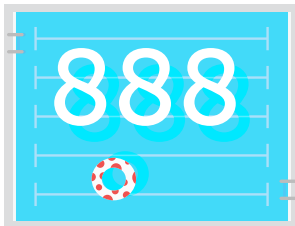


We care about quality! Each year, we treat **30 billion gallons** of water with reverse osmosis.

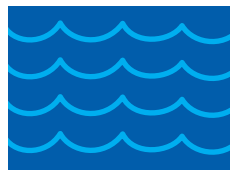
Western is part of a collaborative team of five agencies that help secure water for generations to come.



## Our Infrastructure

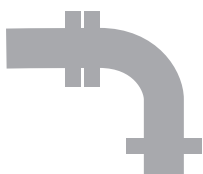


Construction on the **Victoria Recharge Basin** began in early 2017 and brings customers a new, local supply of up to 888 1/2 Olympic size pools of water each year.



The **Arlington Desalter** removes salt and impurities to supply **3.7 million gallons** new water each day.

The **La Sierra Pipeline** will provide safe drinking water to more than 7,000 homes. Construction will be complete in late 2019.



The expansion of the **Chino Desalter** in Jurupa Valley doubled the facility's production capacity and now keeps water flowing to more than **350,000 homes.**

The **Seven Oaks Dam** is our best defense to collect stormwater and help us prepare for future droughts.

We promise to keep exploring new strategies that will increase water supplies and update our **Integrated Regional Water Management Plan** to reflect those innovations.



We teach our adults and children about water-use efficiency by offering free efficiency evaluations, classes at our water-wise demonstration garden and in the classroom!
