ART CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. "Water is Life" is the theme. Art will be judged on theme clarity, neatness/quality and creativity/originality.
2. BOLD, BRIGHT, BRILLIANT colors show up best! Students may use the following media: crayons, markers, pencils, paints, watercolors, chalks, cut paper and/or fabric.
3. Art MUST be drawn HORIZONTALLY (a graphics requirement).
4. Words must be spelled CORRECTLY.
5. Only ORIGINAL artwork will be accepted. No copying of others' artwork, computer-generated, traced, trademarked or copyrighted characters and slogans.
6. Art should depict various water uses and/or "wise" water use at home or school, in industries or businesses, in the environment, in agriculture, recreation or water use in health and safety.
7. Artwork MUST be "truly" the hands-on work of the student and realistically represent the age, grade and developmental skill level of the student.
8. Submissions become the property of Western and may not be returned.
